

ADVENT SEASON PRAYER PROMPTS | Week 2

SUNDAY:

- Read Luke 1:10 - pray that everyone who sets foot on one of our locations would experience the presence of God..
- Pray for Coalition of Compassion and Justice (CCJ), a ministry partner who serves the homeless in our communities.
- Pray that the message this morning would be delivered faithfully, and bring God glory.
- Pray for your ONE and for their invite to Christmas services, that they would come and would experience God.
- Pray that God would grow and strengthen marriages here at QuadCity, reminding husbands and wives that Jesus is the foundation of their relationship.

MONDAY:

- Reflect on the powerful gospel story in Luke 1:5-25; What stands out to you about God's faithfulness? Pray for great faith and for strength to be obedient today.
- Pray for God to best prepare you to be used for His glory in your work, family, school, hobbies and ministry.
- Pray for the one person who God may be asking you to share the hope of Jesus with this month.
- Pray for a specific thing God has blessed you with, that you are most thankful for.
- Pray for the QuadCity Kids ministry team that they would help to teach our kids to know, love, and obey Jesus all the days of their lives.

TUESDAY:

- Pray for A Safe Place, a homeless ministry that is based out of Prescott Valley
 - Pray for their volunteers to remain steadfast and encouraged, and for the board to be able to remain focused on what God wants them to do.
 - Pray that A Safe Place would continue to be funded so that they can care for the needy.
- Pray for revival in our QuadCities area, that people here can walk with and know Jesus on a personal level.
- Pray for our Discipleship Group leaders as they lead, admonish and encourage their group.
- Pray for the community meals volunteers that they would serve people with love, compassion and understanding this Christmas season and every Tuesday.
- Give thanks to God for the families who drew closer to the Lord and to each other this week. For them to continue to pursue love and faithfulness.

WEDNESDAY:

- Pray for our student leadership teams at both of our campuses. Ask that they grow in maturity and leadership; and that they also grow in humility.
- Pray that our families would be successful at teaching their kids what this season means
- Pray for the Jesus loving students in our community to be a light for Jesus to the students who don't know Him.
- Pray for the people who attended Candy Crawl in October and the PV Findlay Halloween event. That God would use their interaction with our church and bring them to a Christmas service!
- Pray for our first impressions team that they would welcome and love people well, as we pray for hundreds to visit our church this month.

THURSDAY:

- Pray for today's meeting with HUSD regarding the easement for the PV campus building.
 - Ask God to give wisdom, clarity of speech, and favor to those representing QuadCity.
 - Ask God to smooth out any obstacles or delays and allow the easement to be signed.
- Pray for the opportunity to do the one hard thing we have been thinking about, for the courage and wisdom to step out in faith and do it.
- Pray for our Life Group leaders as they lead each week. For hospitality, insight and grace as they open their homes.
- Pray for a way to meet the needs of the homeless in a tangible way this month.
- Give thanks for the 107 baptisms that we had this year and let's pray for that to be doubled next year!

FRIDAY:

- Pray for God to remind you of someone who is particularly lonely this season, and for the courage to spend quality time with them.
- Praise God for how many new people the gospel is reaching globally in 2025.
- Pray for the cafe team as they prepare to show Christ-like hospitality each Sunday, and for the moments they have been able to serve meals to grieving families during memorials.
- Pray for the many young people God is continuing to reach and for many more to hear the word preached here at QuadCity.
- Thank God for the new families that were formed this year, and for the Lord to richly bless them.

SATURDAY:

- Pray for Community Pregnancy Center to maintain their funding, and that Jesus would use that ministry to serve women in need, and support those that need it after the birth of their child
- Pray for all of the volunteers at your campus as they serve to make each Sunday happen; for God to guide them as they serve at the Christmas Eve services.
- Pray for dozens more baptisms to happen during the month of December, for more soft hearts saying yes to Jesus.
- Pray for the opportunity to show love and compassion to a difficult family member who the world may view as an outsider.
- Pray for the marriages in our church to seek Christ first and put selfishness aside for the sake of the Kingdom and leading a Godly family.

Five Finger Prayer Prompt

Thumb: People most important to me...just like the thumb is the most important appendage on the hand, who are the people most important to me?

Pointer: Those who point the way...lead in the community...lead in the church

Middle Finger: Those who influence or are "outside" culture (Politics, authority)

Ring Finger: The "weakest" among us. Chronically/terminally ill, homeless or addicted, widows with no one to care for them; people who are forgotten or invisible.

Pinky: Prayers for me come last...I've been given the gift of proper perspective by putting the needs of others before mine
