3. Luke cared about people who felt left out. Who is someone you can encourage or include this week?
4. Luke wasn't an eyewitness but talked to people who were. Who can you talk to about faith that might help you grow?
5. Luke wrote for people who didn't grow up knowing the Bible. What part of the Bible is still confusing to you?
6. As we begin this new series, what is one habit you want to start to help you read Scripture more regularly?
7. Luke highlighted the poor, the hurting, and those overlooked. Who around you might need kindness today?
8. Theophilus needed reassurance. What is one question about faith you'd like to ask God?
9. Luke wrote things "in order" so people could understand better. What helps you understand the Bible more clearly?
10. Jesus is the Savior of the whole world. How can you share His love with someone this week?
