## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why does John call people to repent before Jesus begins His ministry?
2. What does John mean when he says he is not worthy to untie Jesus' sandals?
3. Why was Jesus baptized even though He was without sin?
4. What do we learn about God from the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit all being present at Jesus' baptism?
5. According to the sermon, what does baptism mean for us today?

### Heart-Level Reflection Questions

1. Where do you feel like you're still "waiting expectantly" for God to move in your life right now?
2. When you hear John's call to repentance, what is one area of your life the Spirit may be inviting you to surrender or change?
3. Do you tend to live trying to earn God's approval, or resting in being loved by Him? What makes you answer that way?
4. What does it stir in you to hear the Father say to Jesus, "You are my beloved"? (Do you believe that same love is available to you in Christ?)
5. What is your next step in responding to the good news—repentance, baptism, obedience, or trusting Jesus more fully?
