DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Where was Jesus led immediately after His baptism?
2. How long was Jesus in the wilderness being tempted?
3. What physical condition was Jesus in during the temptation?
4. How did Jesus respond each time the devil tempted Him?
5. What was the main strategy the devil used in tempting Jesus (shortcut, questioning identity, twisting Scripture)?

Heart-Level Reflection Questions

1. When you are most tired, isolated, or depleted, where do you feel most vulnerable to temptation?
2. What legitimate need in your life are you most tempted to meet in illegitimate ways?
3. Where might you be looking for a “shortcut” instead of trusting God’s timing and plan?
4. When the enemy questions your identity or worth, what truth from God’s Word do you need to hold onto?
5. What would it look like for you this week to “live like Jesus” in the middle of a real temptation you’re facing?
