DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. According to Luke 4, what did Jesus say He came to do?
2. Why is it important that Jesus' ministry was empowered by the Holy Spirit?
3. What does it mean that Jesus fulfilled the prophecy in Isaiah 61?
4. Why do you think Jesus made gathering with God's people a regular habit?
5. What is one way we can live out the good news of Jesus' kingdom this week?

Heart-Level Reflection Questions

1. Where in your life right now do you most need the freedom Jesus offers—what feels like captivity, blindness, or oppression for you?
2. What keeps you from fully receiving the good news of Jesus in your own life—pride, fear, self-reliance, or something else?
3. How has the Holy Spirit been at work in your life recently, and where might He be inviting you to depend on Him more?
4. Is gathering with God's people a priority in your life, or has something else slowly taken its place? What is one step you could take to make it a habit again?
5. Who around you right now needs to experience the hope and favor of Jesus, and how might God be inviting you to embody and proclaim that good news to them this week?
