DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why did Jesus leave Nazareth and go to Capernaum?
2. What trade route ran through Capernaum that made it an important place for Jesus' ministry?
3. How did the people respond to Jesus' teaching in the synagogue?
4. What did the demon call Jesus when it cried out in the synagogue?
5. What happened to the demon when Jesus commanded it to come out of the man?

Heart-Level Reflection Questions

1. Jesus taught with authority. What is one area of your life where you struggle to fully trust or submit to the authority of Jesus?
2. The enemy often works through lies and deception. What is a lie about God, yourself, or your worth that you have struggled to believe?
3. The message described different ways the enemy tries to influence people. Where have you personally experienced spiritual struggle or temptation, and what helped you resist it?
4. The demon immediately recognized who Jesus was, while many people did not. What does it look like for you to truly acknowledge Jesus as the "Holy One of God" in your daily life?
5. Scripture reminds us that "the one who is in you is greater than the one who is in the world." How would your fears, worries, or spiritual battles change if you truly lived with that confidence?
