DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Where was Jesus teaching when he called Peter to follow him?
2. What was Peter's job before he began following Jesus?
3. What did Jesus tell Peter to do after they had caught no fish all night?
4. How did Peter respond when he realized who Jesus truly was?
5. What did Jesus say Peter would start doing instead of fishing for fish?

Heart-Level Reflection Questions

1. Do you feel like you are truly following Jesus, or mostly just "following Him around" like part of the crowd?
2. Is there an area of your life where Jesus is saying, "Trust me and do it my way," but you've been resisting?
3. When was the last time you honestly recognized your own need for Jesus the way Peter did when he said, "I am a sinful man"?
4. Who are the people in your life that you are praying for or hoping to introduce to Jesus?
5. What might Jesus be asking you to leave behind in order to follow Him more fully?
