DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. After leaving the synagogue, whose home did Jesus go to?
2. What illness was Simon's mother-in-law suffering from?
3. What did Jesus do to the fever before it left her?
4. What did Simon's mother-in-law do immediately after she was healed?
5. What did Jesus say was the reason He was sent (Luke 4:43)?

Heart-Level Reflection Questions

1. Throughout the passage people were amazed by Jesus' authority and miracles, but they were not yet following Him. In what ways might you admire or appreciate Jesus without fully surrendering your life to Him?
2. Simon invited Jesus into his home and into a very personal moment of pain. What area of your life—hurt, fear, struggle, or brokenness—do you need to invite Jesus into right now?
3. Jesus showed incredible tenderness by laying His hands on each person and healing them individually. How have you personally experienced the compassion or care of Jesus in your life?
4. After a powerful day of ministry, Jesus withdrew to a solitary place to pray. What does your current rhythm of time with God look like, and what might it look like to intentionally create space to meet with Him?
5. The crowd wanted Jesus to stay and continue meeting their needs, but Jesus was focused on proclaiming the kingdom of God. Where might you be asking Jesus simply to fix your situation instead of allowing Him to reign over your whole life?
