DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. Why does Luke list all the rulers and leaders at the beginning of Luke 3?
2. Who did “the word of God” come to, and where was he when it came?
3. What two action steps did John call people to take for the forgiveness of sins?
4. According to Luke 7, what happened later to people who were baptized by John versus those who were not?
5. What was the main purpose of John the Baptist’s ministry according to Luke 1:16–17 and Isaiah 40?

Heart-Level Reflection Questions

1. Where might pride, comfort, or self-reliance be keeping me from admitting that I need help with my sin?
2. What is one clear act of obedience God has already placed in front of me that I’ve been delaying or resisting?
3. If repentance is about removing obstacles so I can see Jesus clearly, what roadblocks might still be in the way of my relationship with Him?
4. Have I ever confused knowing about God—Scripture, church activity, or theology—with truly surrendering my life to Him? Where do I see that tension in myself right now?
5. What might I be missing out on spiritually because I haven’t fully responded to what God is asking of me today
